Water Availability

- 2017 Colorado River Lower Basin State Diversions
 - Intentionally Created Surplus (ICS) Operating Condition – AZ 2.8 MAF
 - Creation of 185 KAF of ICS and system water projected
 - Central Arizona Project 1.47 MAF
 - On-River 1.15 MAF
- CAWCD Policy for Distributing Excess CAP Water
 - Statutory Firming Pool
 - Volume determined annually
 - 18,630 AF available to pool in 2017
 - AWBA share of pool 17,630 AF

2017 Funding Sources

- Withdrawal fees collected in Phoenix, Pinal and Tucson AMAs
- 4¢ Ad valorem tax
 - Levied by CAWCD in Maricopa, Pinal, and Pima Counties
 - Retained in CAWCD fund accounts
 - Utilized by CAWCD to offset AWBA water storage and delivery costs as part of project O&M costs
 - Reserved by CAWCD Board for potential long-term storage credit purchases

Storage Facility Capacity

- Discussions with storage facility operators on storage opportunities
- Emphasis on GSF storage
- Additional storage capacity available if needed
