<p>The CAGRDR believes that Alternative Firming Method 1 (phased approach) scenarios 1B or 1C could best achieve a balance between incrementally reducing firming percentages over time and the practical administration by AWBA of the proposed policy revision.</p> <p>Additionally, the CAGRDR is not a water provider and therefore does not directly deliver water to a customer base. The to-be-determined implementation measures include in AWBA's proposed Alternative Firming Method 2 (incentive-based approach) are unachievable for CAGRDR. CAGRDR does not have the statutory or regulatory authority to limit non-essential water use through ordinances, seek ACC-approved tariffs or rate structures or require our enrolled members to significantly reduce residential, commercial or industrial water uses.</p>	N/A	N/A
