RESOLUTION NO. 22351

RELATING TO WATER; AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF A PURCHASE AND SALE AGREEMENT FOR LONG-TERM STORAGE CREDITS BETWEEN THE ARIZONA WATER BANKING AUTHORITY (AWBA) AND THE CITY OF TUCSON FOR THE PURPOSE OF FIRING WATER SUPPLIES FOR THE TUCSON ACTIVE MANAGEMENT AREA (AMA); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUCSON, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Purchase and Sale Agreement for Long-Term Storage Credits between the AWBA and the City of Tucson for the purpose of firming water supplies for the Tucson AMA, attached as Exhibit "A," is approved.



SECTION 3. The various City officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this Resolution.


SECTION 4. WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Tucson that this Resolution become immediately

effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.


